00.00 – 00.30	I was born in 1941, and my earliest memory is, when I was about two and a half, my Dad lifted me up so that I could see the grass all alight where the planes had flown over and dropped incendiary bombs, 'cos they were looking for the guns that were in Gunnersbury Park, just in front of where the nurseries are now, the Greenscene Nurseries are now. There were guns there, it was like a little village, 'cos they had wooden huts and the guns and everything. They dropped the incendiary bombs to try and find them, but they were hidden by the trees.
00.30 -	In our loft, we had corrugated iron down, and asbestos, so that if incendiaries came through the roof they would burn on that, and not come down and set the house on fire.
