This gallery is a showcase for our diverse local history collection, with one object linking to each of the museum galleries. Keep exploring to find out more!


### Historic Kitchens

### Home


This gallery focuses on the health, worship and education of the local residents. Discover life before the NHS, Victorian curriculums and the largest Gurdwara outside India.

## 2nd Floor




### Industry


